Different level consist different members in which Ms. Ayesha, Mr. Tejvir Singh & Mr. Radheyshyam were common. Online entry filled by Mr. Radheyshyam and details were collected by Ms. Ayesha through Mr. Tejvir Singh. Different level's information are as follows:

1. Food - This level required information about lunch brought by the students, canteen's information & various food programmes served / sold / sponsored in school.

2. Energy – In this level different source of energy like LPG, Diesel, Petrol, CNG's consumption in school asked. There is a calculation of energy consumption is actually in school premises.
3. Water – Consumption of water, facilities of water like sanitation, kitchen etc. is asked. There was information for Rain Water Harvesting System if working then sends detail.
4. Land – In this level there was an idea about the land area of school which is divided in Green cover, landscaped area, concerts area, buildup etc. includes the idea about whether the school building is well ventilated or not.
5. Waste – This was actually the backbone of this programme which confers the report about the waste management in school. In this level information of waste collection point in ground, classes, reception and its' dumping in authorized / unauthorized places asked in Kg. It was also asked the waste product like paper, electrical etc per month in kg.

These all levels are also asked to submit various evidences to support our audit occurring in school. This audit started on 14 October 2016 and completed on 16 November 2016. Last date for completion of audit & online submission was 18 November 2016.
